# Why not 2024 in Reno?

- The NPTC Steering Committee established a venue rotation plan pre-COVID.
- 2016 Jacksonville, 2017 Reno, 2018 Reno
- 2019 Naples, 2020 and 2021 Virtual
- The NPTC contract in Reno rolled over during the pandemic
- 2022 and 2023 Reno, 2024 Fort Lauderdale
- 2025 and 2026 Reno, 2027 ???

## Why two years in Reno?

- Compared to east coast and other venues, Reno is less expensive from accommodations to catering to conference space.
- This provides an affordable registration fee for the insurance company attendees, consultants and vendors when compared to other tax conferences.
- The economics of the venue rotation plan allows the NPTC to subsidize the conference registration fee at a different location without sacrificing the quality and length of the conference.
- An affordable registration fee will minimize the overall cost of attendance for all.

# How much will it cost to attend the 2024 NPTC?

- The NPTC Steering Committee is committed to keeping the registration fee as low as possible for the insurance company attendees and the consultant attendees by not raising the fee more than \$100 above the 2023 registration fee.
- At this time, the estimated Insurance Company Attendee registration fee will be \$700. (2023 fee = \$650)
- At this time, the estimated Consultant registration fee will be \$950. (2023 fee = \$950)
- The registration fee will also include the Opening Reception refreshments, Breakfast (Wednesday – Friday), and Lunch (Wednesday – Friday), and daily beverage service.



# How much will the Hilton Fort Lauderdale Marina cost?

- Hilton Fort Lauderdale Marina Accommodations:
- The NPTC is pleased to have negotiated the following nightly rate:
  - Standard Guest Room with a balcony overlooking the marina or intercoastal waterway.
  - \$229.00 plus tax per night, including guest room WIFI. The NPTC negotiated the daily resort fee be waived. This is a savings of \$30 per day.
  - Rate is applicable three days prior and post conference subject to availability.

One night deposit will be charged to the attendee credit card when the reservation is made.

NPTC attendees must use a reservation link which will be provided with your 2024 registration confirmation

- On-site parking is available for an overnight fee of \$46.00 per night.

# Getting around Fort Lauderdale

- By foot: There are dining and shopping options within one-mile of the Hilton.
- By Water Taxi: One daily ticket, unlimited rides from 5 – 10 pm. There is a taxi dock at the Hilton Marina. Two routes: The Fort Lauderdale Route and the Hollywood Express Route. Both routes offer dining and shopping options. The NPTC is currently negotiating a group rate for the daily ticket.
